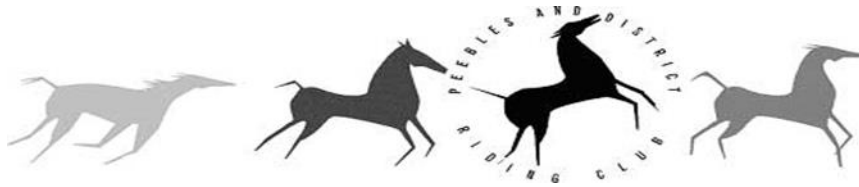


Rules and Conditions for Peebles and District Riding Club shows

1. The competition is run under official Riding Club rules.
2. All competitors must be paid up members of a BHS affiliated Riding Club or Pony Club, or be BHS Gold Card members. Others who wish to compete must provide proof that they have their own third party liability insurance that offers similar cover to the BRC insurance policy when they declare/make an entry.
3. Members and those who have helped at previous PDRC events will be given priority entry.
4. Anyone mounted at the event must ensure that their riding hat conforms to current BRC standards (see <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads>) and that it is worn by with the harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur a £10 fine and request to leave the event. Back protectors adhering to BRC standards are recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross-country.
5. Save for death or personal injury caused by negligence, neither the organisers on the day, nor Peebles & District Riding Club, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground spectators or other person or property whatsoever and entries are only accepted under this condition.
6. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
7. There may be a photographer in attendance. Photographs taken may be used on the PDRC website, Facebook page or in other publications to promote and celebrate PDRC's activities. If you do not wish your photograph or your child's photograph to be taken please indicate this on your entry.
8. PDRC will use your personal data provided with your entry for the purpose of running the event and by submitting your entry, you consent to receiving communications about the event by post, email, SMS/MMS, online or phone unless you explicitly state otherwise.
9. At venues that allow dogs (please check the schedule) these must be kept on a lead, and all faeces must be collected and disposed of in an appropriate manner.
10. Please note that it is a legal requirement that horses and ponies are travelled with their correct passports. Passports should be available for inspection by the organisers at any time. We recommend all horses are vaccinated for equine influenza following the [BRC rules](#).
11. Every effort will be made to keep to the given times. Competitors must declare themselves to the steward at least 10 minutes before they are due to compete.
12. No competitor may enter more than 3 classes per horse for each section (eg dressage/show jumping).
13. Classes may be split, combined or cancelled at the organiser's/judge's discretion
14. Horses must be 4 years old or over
15. Unless the schedule explicitly states otherwise, entries will be accepted only on the official entry form (which may be online) and must be prepaid.
16. The judge's decision is final. Any objections should be lodged in writing within one hour of the class with £20 deposit, which will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
17. Any exceptions to the entry restrictions will be at the discretion of the organiser.
18. No refunds can be given after the closing date.
19. In the event of cancellation, a minimum of 75% of entry fees will be refunded to those who request it.
20. Riders are responsible for lifting any muck which their horse deposits and will be excluded from the competition if found to not to comply with this condition. No mucking out of boxes at the venue. Please also take away hay, shavings and rubbish from around your trailer/box.



21. Stallions can only be brought to a show with prior notification and permission granted from the entries secretary. The stallion must wear a stallion disc at the show.
22. If your horse/pony is showing any signs of an infectious or contagious disease or is coming from a yard where either exists, please show some common sense and stay away.
